DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Space Spray: Use **ISLAND BREEZE** straight and spray in a wide trigger spray pattern setting towards the center of the room.

Contact Spray: Use **ISLAND BREEZE** straight and spray in a wide trigger spray pattern directly on the source of the malodor.

Mop Additive Solution: Use **ISLAND BREEZE** at a dilution of 2 oz. to 8 oz. per gallon.

Extraction Additive: Use **ISLAND BREEZE** at a dilution of 2 oz. to 8 oz. per gallon.

Carpet and Upholstery Spray: Use **ISLAND BREEZE** at a dilution of 2 oz. to 8 oz. per quart for general use.

Precautions
